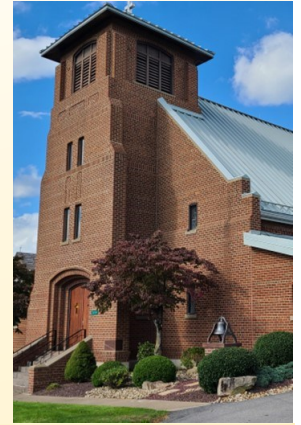

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Call Father anytime 724-423-3777.

Please Note: By law, Hospitals and Care Facilities are prevented from notifying us of admissions or status changes. Please contact the Office to request visits or Communion calls as soon as possible.

RECONCILIATION (Confession): ½ hour before Mass or by appt.

BAPTISMS: Call the pastor to schedule & prepare for Baptism.

Please Note: Certificates to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation can only be given to one who is a registered and practicing member of the Parish.

WEDDINGS: Couples must meet with the pastor at least twelve months in advance of the planned marriage date.

Discipleship: Following The Way Of The Lord Jesus

Some families will go years before addressing a problem. Grudges or resentments between people more often die with those who hold them, rather than come to resolution in quiet conversation. We bind ourselves up with our lack of forgiveness. And what we bind on earth, is bound in heaven.

Today's Gospel reminds us of the importance of our Church community. Jesus urges us not to tolerate silently the dysfunction in our lives, but to confront relationship problems, misunderstandings and issues that divide us and embitter us. He calls us to the hard work of seeking solutions to our problems, not out of anger, nor a sense of injustice for what we have suffered, but out of a commitment to imitate the great love and mercy of God. He calls us to put aside anger and wounded pride in order to take those first, difficult steps in healing our relationships.

Jesus also says: *For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.* While it is true that a person can pray or act alone, Jesus makes it clear that our coming together in His name multiplies the power. He tells us that if we pray and work with the Holy Spirit guiding us, with God's Spirit intentionally a part of what we do, we become much more than simply the collective number of people we are.

Long ago, poet John Donne reminded us: *No man is an island, entire unto himself.* When you deny your gifts to one another, you are denying it to God. And, when we misuse God's gifts, we can be certain that Christ is not present in our midst; we have not gathered in His name.

"Are there people sick among you?

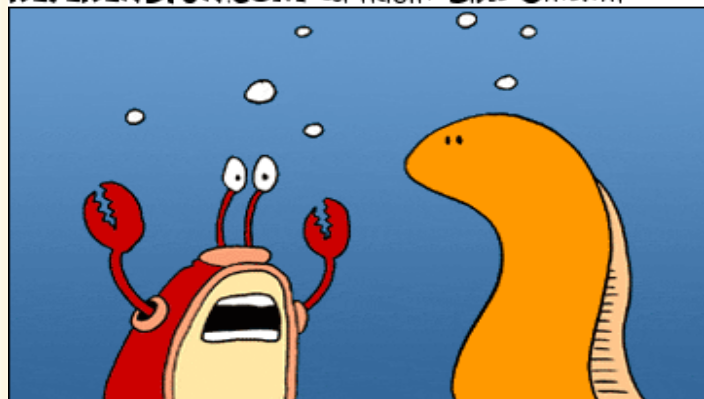
